

## Word Study Psalm 16:11



# 56:7

'fullness' (H7648) שִׂבְעָ (soba')

Lev 25:19 - Then the land will yield its fruit, and you will eat your fill and live there in safety.

Prov 13:25 - The righteous eat to their hearts' **content**, but the stomach of the wicked goes hungry.

Psalm 90:14 - **Satisfy** us in the morning with your unfailing love, that we may sing for joy and be glad all our days.

“You will make known to me the path of life; In Your presence is fullness of joy; In Your right hand there are pleasures forever.” (NASB)

pleasures (H5273) נְעִיִם (na'iyim)

Job 36:11 - If they obey and serve him, they will spend the rest of their days in prosperity and their years in **contentment**.

Psalm 16:6 - The boundary lines have fallen for me in **pleasant** places; surely I have a delightful inheritance.

Luke 10:21 - At that time Jesus, full of joy through the Holy Spirit, said, "I praise you, Father, Lord of heaven and earth, because you have hidden these things from the wise and learned, and revealed them to little children. Yes, Father, for this was your good **pleasure**.

joy (H8057) שִׂמְחָה (simkhah)

1 Kings 1:40 - And all the people went up after him, playing flutes and **rejoicing** greatly, so that the ground shook with the sound.

Psalm 21:6 - Surely you have granted him eternal blessings and made him **glad** with the joy of your presence.

Song of Songs 3:11 - Go forth, O ye daughters of Zion, and behold king Solomon with the crown wherewith his mother crowned him in the day of his espousals, and in the day of the **gladness** of his heart. (KJV)

Isa 56:7 - these I will bring to my holy mountain and give them **joy**\* in my house of prayer... \*H8055 Samakh, the root of 'simkhah 8057
