

Clean (H2889) טָהוֹר (tahowr)
- clear, unmixed : primitive root carries connotation of 'brightness': a related Syraic word means 'noon'

Synonyms: clear, unmixed, pure, undefiled, sacred

Ezra 6:20 - For the priests and the Levites had **purified** themselves together; all of them were **clean**. So they slaughtered the Passover lamb for all the returned exiles, for their fellow priests, and for themselves.

Psalm 12:6 - And the words of the LORD are **flawless**, like silver purified in a crucible, like gold refined seven times.

Matt 5:8 - Blessed are the **pure** in heart, for they will see God.

2 Tim 2:20,21 - some are for special purposes and some for common use. Those who cleanse themselves from the latter will be instruments for special purposes, made holy, useful to the Master and prepared to do any good work.

Rev 7:14 - I answered, "Sir, you know." And he said, "These are they who have come out of the great tribulation; they have **washed their robes** and made them white in the blood of the Lamb.

Renew (H2318) שִׁדְּדָה (chadash)
-primitive meaning has association with the idea of polishing a sword.

Synonyms: mend, rejuvenate, revitalize, restore, replenish, galvanize

1 Sa 11:14 - Then Samuel said to the people, "Come, let us go to Gilgal and there **renew** the kingdom."

Psalm 104:30 - When you send your Spirit, they are created, and you **renew** the face of the earth.

Prov 3:19 - Turn us back to You, O LORD, and we will be restored; **renew** our days as of old

Isa 61:4 - They will rebuild the ancient ruins and (raise up) the places long devastated; they will **renew** the ruined cities that have been devastated for generations

Heart (H3820) לֵב (Layv)

Synonyms: seat of the emotions, seat of appetites, courage, the "misdst" of something

-primitive meaning seems to refer to a smoothed or hollowed out place this would seem to make sense since one is speaking about our "inmost parts" or perhaps an "inner house" in which reside many aspects of our non-physical being

Prov 10:13 - On the lips of the discerning, wisdom is found, But a rod is for the back of him who lacks **understanding**.

Prov 13:12 - Hope deferred makes the **heart** sick, but a longing fulfilled is a tree of life.

Ecc 9:7 - Go, eat your bread with joy, and drink your wine with a merry **heart**; for God has already accepted your works

Isa 44:19 - And no one considers in his **heart**, Nor is there knowledge nor understanding to say, " I have burned half of it in the fire, Yes, I have also baked bread on its coals; I have roasted meat and eaten it; And shall I make the rest of it an abomination? Shall I fall down before a block of wood?"

Spirit (H7307) רוּחַ (ruwach)

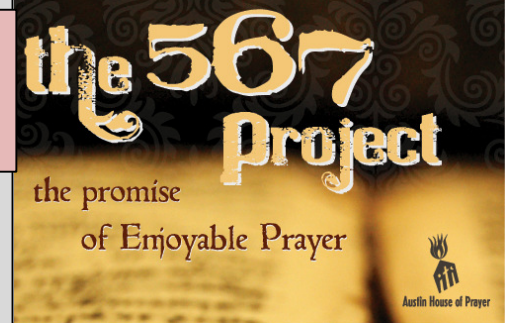
- Breath, wind, vital force, inner disposition,

Gen 1:2 - Now the earth was formless and empty, darkness was over the surface of the deep, and the **Spirit** of God was hovering over the waters.

Exod 31:3 - and I have filled him with the **Spirit** of God, with wisdom, with understanding, with knowledge and with all kinds of skills—

Psalm 77:6 - I call to remembrance my song in the night; I meditate within my heart, and my **spirit** makes diligent search (NKJV)

Prov 25:28 - Whoever has no rule over his own **spirit** Is like a city broken down, without walls (NKJV)
